How we are spending Pupil Premium 2013-2014

We have to make sure as much happens to support these children so that they achieve at least expected progress. The government currently funds it at £900. We have used it for:

Music Lessons for particular individuals

Teaching Assistant Support in classrooms to support specific learning

Interventions in spelling, comprehension and maths

Visits and residential experiences for specific individuals who qualify

Self- esteem groups and activities

Additional activities at lunchtimes to nurture children and support positive unstructured times

Additional phonics booster groups

Reading support targeted, including Better Reading Programme

Stage Group activities to develop self-confidence and skills

Services bought in from outside agencies to support individual needs
