

### **Modern Foreign Languages overview (KS1)**

Young pupils are very receptive to learning a new language; they like to mimic pronunciation and they can easily pick up and duplicate new sounds. The children feel a real sense of accomplishment when they learn to say something in a new language. Repetition and practice are essential in learning a new language, so songs and games such as 'Simple Simon Says' and 'What's in the bag?' will be regularly used. In the Autumn Term we have a humanities and cultural week when all children will take part in a French Day and also experience language in a different classroom. Spanish is also offered throughout the year.
