On Tuesday night we took part in our second round of matches of the Year 3 & 4 mixed football tournament at Callington CC, looking to back up our excellent start in round one of the fixtures.

Our first match was against Callington, who had a striker who scored 10 goals in a single game last week. Thanks to James and Grace at the back and William, Ethan and Anna in midfield we harried and gave this player very little time on the ball - meaning that Max in the SRG goal was largely a spectator in the first half. We took the lead on 6 minutes when Tom took a quick free kick and smashed the ball into the roof of the net. The score stayed that way until half time. Our second game was a much closer affair against Lifton Primary. We played some lovely football in the opening 6 minutes and deservedly took a 2:0 thanks to a ninth goal in four games from Tom and an excellent team goal involving James, Charlie D and Ryan which was finished off by Ethan. It was no surprise then that Lifton scored a goal just before the break.

Thankfully, we held on to our slender advantage to record a hard-fought 2:1 victory and extend our unbeaten run to 4 matches.
