

Dear Parent/Carers of Year 4,

We have booked the Year 4 children's residential this year again with The Spirit of Adventure and will be returning to Dittisham, near Dartmouth at the end of April/ beginning of May in 2024. The pupils will be building upon their Year 3 residential experience and hopefully having a lot of fun. In previous years, the Year 4 children have labelled the adventure 'I'm a Year 4, get me out of here!' and have really enjoyed the trip.

Returning to Dittisham where we have exclusive use, the class will have time to spend together and reflect on the many successes of the year so far. As we have a great working relationship with the staff there we have been able to secure the package with a discount on the normal summer prices.

Year 4 will go on Tuesday 30<sup>th</sup> April and return on Wednesday 1st May 2024.

The cost for the two-day visit will be £108. This cost includes all the instructors, equipment hire for activities, transport (we have negotiated the best possible price on coach travel), accommodation in forest huts, breakfast, an evening meal and a lunch. This is an initial letter to enable those who would like to pay over a number of weeks to do so.

More details of the programme will be sent out next term but children will need to take a reasonably warm sleeping bag and warm clothing suitable for outdoor adventure activities.
